This coming Tuesday, as mentioned before, we will sponsor a day of Eucharistic Adoration, concluding with a Holy Hour and followed by a dinner. It is hoped we can all participate in some way.

Mass will be held at the usual time, 9:00 am at St Francis. After that, the Blessed Sacrament will then be exposed for Adoration in the monstrance throughout the day. Sign up sheets will

guarantee someone will be present each hour – a way for us to demonstrate that we are parishioners on the same team.

At 5:30, we will gather for a Holy Hour featuring Vespers (Liturgy of the Hours) with a talk on the value of the Eucharist. My brother, Deacon Dave Jacquel, will speak on this priceless gift out of the Church's understanding, his own experiences, and the experience of the National Eucharistic Congress held in Indianapolis this summer. It was featured in the *FAITH* magazine we all received in our homes recently.

We will conclude the Holy Hour with Benediction, the blessing of those present with the Blessed Sacrament. We have received so much in the presence of Jesus' Body and Blood, and this is another way to celebrate that in union with our weekly (or daily) participation in Mass.

We shall then join together in a meal at Ritchie Hall. It's been our custom on October 4<sup>th</sup> to do that, but that day falls on Friday and that would be competing with many other events, so we transferred it to Monday. Bring a salad, side, or dessert and we can share this wonderful time and company together. It is envisioned to continue this tradition in the future, even after we've moved all activities to St Bernard's, because St Francis continues to truly inspire us all.



#### FIRST FRIDAY AT ST. BERNARD





#### BULLETIN INFORMATION MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING BY NOON ON FRIDAY 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO BULLETIN DATE.

MEMBERSHIP: All Baptized Catholics should be registered, practicing and supporting members of a Parish. Only properly registered members appear on our parish list and are eligible to receive the benefits of parish membership for sacraments. Each parishioner is called upon to practice good stewardship of time, talent and treasure. If you are not currently receiving envelopes, you may not be registered. Call the Parish Office - we would love to meet you!

**MARRIAGE:** Couples need to contact a priest *at least six months before their wedding*. Registered and active participation needs to be considered before marriage.

#### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS:

We welcome all inquiries about the Catholic faith. This **RCIA** process begins in the fall of the year. Please call the Parish Office for further information.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK: Please call the Parish Office to request the Sacrament of the Sick for family members who are seriously ill. Communion for the sick is taken to the hospital, nursing homes, and the homebound on a regular basis.

**BAPTISM:** Both parents must attend the Pre-Baptism Preparation Program. Please call the St. Bernard Parish Office for dates and times of upcoming class.
